Warning

The replacement of this fuel measuring instrument involves the risk of spillage of petroleum which can lead to fire.

Prior to the removal of the fuel measuring instrument unit from the fuel tank ensure that the fuel tank is empty.

Do not

- Rely on the vehicle user's word for this.
- Empty the tank by removing the measuring instrument.

Safety Precautions

The following precautions should also be adhered to:

1. Never drain a tank with the vehicle positioned over a pit.
2. Always use a lift in a well ventilated area.
3. When draining the tank, suitable notices should be displayed, eg, Tank Draining – No smoking or naked lights.
4. If a spillage occurs, this should be dealt with immediately.
5. Lead lamps should not be used during draining operations.
6. Check with your local Fire Authority and Petroleum Licence Regulations to ensure you are permitted to charge and discharge fuel tanks.
7. Use only a safe fuel retrieval system for draining the fuel system, as recommended.

Recommended Method

It is recommended that Fuel Draining Equipment, reference number KM 2351 with adaptor kit KM 2352 is used for the purpose of draining fuel tanks fitted to Vauxhall models.
